



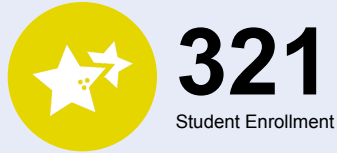

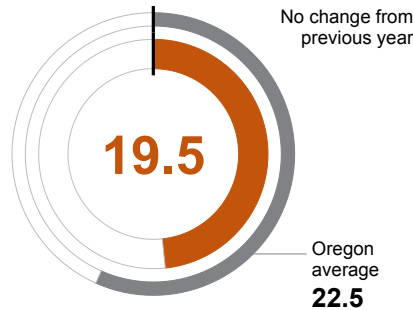

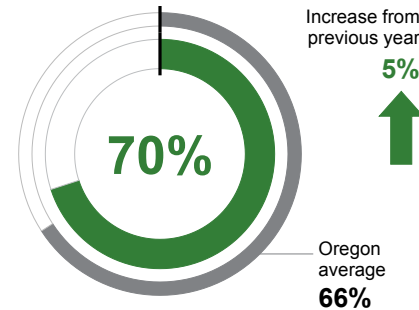

CLASS SIZE Median class size.



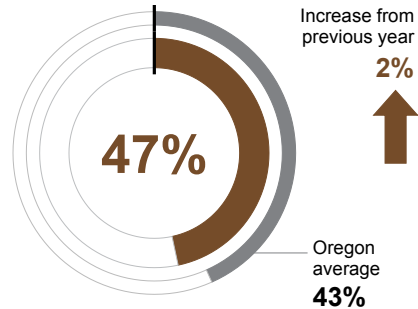

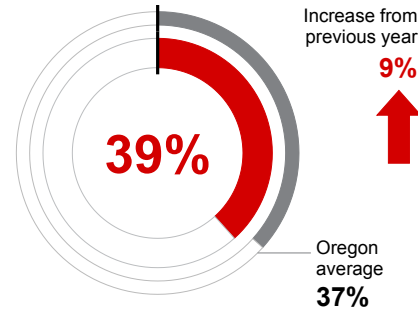
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



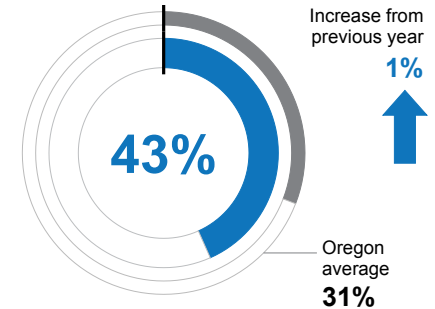
MATHEMATICS
