- Sign up for updates on bills that are important to you. This is how to know when you can provide testimony.

Sharing Your Voice

- Communicate with your representatives
 - Call, email, meet any time while the bill is being heard.
 - Establish a relationship with your representatives so they know what is important to you.
- Submit public testimony (written and/or verbally)
 - Verbal testimony can be shared in person and sometimes virtually the day a bill is heard.
 - Written testimony can be submitted up until 48 hours after a bill is heard.
 - Share your story. The why matters.
 - Be concise and practice if you are testifying verbally. Remember you only have a couple minutes to share your thoughts.



Remember: Your voice matters.
